Thrift Store Volunteer Opportunities

- **Clothing preparation:** Prepares clothing for the retail floor. Mainly placing garments on hangers and tagging and pricing. Job may include doing some laundry or stocking clothing on the retail floor. This job is perfect for the shy person who likes to remain behind the scenes, and can be done in one to two hour volunteer shifts any time between noon and 5:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday.
- **Light Housekeeping:** Vacuuming retail floor, washing windows, dusting, and sweeping front sidewalk. This job is perfect for the neat-nick who gets immense satisfaction from a shiny window and a gleaming shelf, and can be done daily starting at 11:30 for approximately one hour Monday through Saturday.
- **Retail Customer Service:** Works on the retail floor greeting customers and answering questions, and may also include restocking shelves and assisting cashier as needed. This job is perfect for the social butterfly, and can be done in one to five hour volunteer shifts any time between noon and 5:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday.
- **Dishwasher:** Prepares dishes, toys, sporting goods and anything else donated that needs a little elbow grease to make it shine. This job is for that special person who knows that their efforts will bring in even more money for the animals at the shelter. Any extra effort put in on our donated items really adds up at the register. This job can be done in one to two hour volunteer shifts any time between noon and 5:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday.
- **Recycling & Dumpster Transport:** Transports presorted recycling to the recycling center in McCall or Donnelly. This job is perfect for the person who has little time to volunteer and an empty truck or large vehicle that they are driving to and from McCall. Garbage and recycling can be picked up between 4:30 and 5:30 Monday through Saturday at the back of the thrift store. Mornings are possible with prior arrangement. You will not only be helping the animals, but its one little baby step towards saving our environment too.
- **Electronics Technician:** Tests all battery or electrical powered donations to make sure they are in working order before going out on the retail floor. This is the perfect job for someone with a little mechanical know-how and a huge amount of curiosity. If you can make an item work, we can sell it! This job can be done in one to two hour volunteer shifts any time between noon and 5:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday.
